UW-Green Bay	<p>Please tell us why you think you are a good fit for UW-Green Bay, and why UW-Green Bay is a good fit for you. You may include personal skills, traits, talents, interests, and experiences that will enrich our campus, as well as aspects of UW-Green Bay that are especially important to you.</p> <p>Please tell us if there are special circumstances or personal challenges that have had an impact on your previous academic record, and that you would like us to take into consideration as we evaluate your admission application. What have you learned from your experience, and how will it influence you as you pursue your college education?</p>
UW-La Crosse	<p>How will your life experiences, commitments, and/or characteristics enrich the UWL campus community?</p> <p>Please respond to one of the following: 1) Tell us about any circumstances that may have had an impact on your academic performance. 2) Tell us why you are interested in attending the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse.</p>
UW-Madison	<p>Consider something in your daily life you think goes unnoticed and write about why it’s important to you. (maximum 650 words)</p> <p>Tell us why you decided to apply to the University of Wisconsin-Madison. In addition, share with us the academic, extracurricular, or research opportunities you would take advantage of as a student. If applicable, provide details of any circumstance that could have had an impact on your academic performance and/or extracurricular involvement.
