STUDENT FINANCIAL SERVICES

At UWM, 89% of new, full-time undergrads received financial aid — including loans, scholarships and grants — in 2022-23. Students and families should apply for financial aid as early as possible. UWM's financial aid advisors are ready to answer questions and help families navigate the process. Most students are eligible to pay for school through installment plans. uwm.edu/financialaid

SCHOLARSHIPS

More than 10,000 students received scholarships in 2023-24. UWM offers merit-based admission scholarships, such as the Chancellor's Merit Scholarship. It's automatically awarded to incoming freshmen based on unweighted GPA and provides up to \$6,000 in aid over four years. uwm.edu/scholarships
