

Daily Visit

Hour-long tour led by a campus ambassador followed by a one-onone meeting with an admissions counselor with the opportunity to customize your visit with other meetings.

Group Visit

Designed for high schools and community-based organizations bringing a group of five students or more to campus. Includes an hourlong campus tour proceeded by an optional information session led by an admissions counselor and/or a selected resource department.

Preview Days

A large, open-house style event consisting of an admissions presentation, a campus tour, faculty meet-and-greet and the opportunity to connect with current UW-Superior students. Preview Days typically last around three and a half hours and are open to students at any stage of the college search process.
