WISCONSIN GUARANTEE



Wisconsin Guarantee (Wisconsin Act 95) requires schools to prepare a class ranking of pupils for the purposes of facilitating guaranteed admissions to the Universities of Wisconsin.

- Class rank determined by GPA on 11th grade transcript
- Top 10%: Admitted to all UWs except UW-Madison
- Top 5%: Admitted to all UWs
- Application and all required materials for admission is required
 - UW-Madison: Early Action Deadline of November 1

ACADEMIC BACKGROUND: TEST SCORES

The Universities of Wisconsin currently do NOT require an ACT and/or SAT score. This applies applicants submitting applications for admission to Fall 2025 to Summer 2027. All Universities will review your application and consider you for admission with or without one of these standards.

ACT/SAT TEST-OPTIONAL

- Students can choose if they want to submit ACT/SAT scores for admission review and will need to indicate a decision on the application for admission
- Students opting out of ACT/SAT scores will not be negatively impacted
- Students choosing to submit ACT/SAT scores must send scores direct to the Admissions Office



ACT/SAT TEST-OPTIONAL

- ACT/SAT test-optional for students applying for undergraduate admission to terms Fall 2026 to Summer 2027
 - Applies to the high school Class of 2026 (current seniors) applying for admission to Fall 2026 term
- TBD for Class of 2027 and beyond

MN-WI RECIPROCITY



- The Minnesota-Wisconsin Higher Education Reciprocity Agreement allows Minnesota and Wisconsin residents to attend higher education institutions in either state without having to pay nonresident tuition.
- Reciprocity benefits will be automatically renewed each year for students attending a reciprocity college or university in Wisconsin.





MSEP



MIDWEST STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM (MSEP)

- Program allows undergraduate and graduate students from participating states, including Indiana, Kansas, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, and Wisconsin to attend colleges or universities in other participating states at a reduced tuition rate.
- Incoming new freshmen who meet criteria will automatically qualify at the time of admission. No separate application is required.

MIDWEST TUITION RATE



NONRESIDENT MIDWEST TUITION RATE

- Tuition reduction program for selected new freshmen who are residents of Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, or South Dakota.
- Midwest Tuition Rate is equivalent to 150% of the tuition a Wisconsin resident would pay.
- Only new freshmen are eligible to be awarded the Midwest Tuition Rate.
- Incoming new freshmen who meet criteria will automatically qualify at the time of admission. No separate application is required.

2026-2027 FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID

- For the 2026-2027 academic year, the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is expected to open on October 1, 2025
